Children's Dental Health Month

February is children's dental health month and this builds on our topics last month during which we discussed keeping our bodies healthy and looking after our teeth. We can see from some of your observations from home that some of the children have already been visiting the dentist which is great!

It is so important that your child Is registered with a dentist as soon as possible and good tooth brushing habits need to start as soon as that first tooth arrives!

We also support your child's oral health by introducing tooth brushing and visits to the dentist during our activities and role play – we have even had a dentist visit the setting to talk to the children previously.
